- Wage and Hour issues including state and local minimum wage increases and the status of the FLSA final overtime rule
- New OSHA and EEOC reporting guidelines
- Developments related to the Massachusetts Pay Equity Law
- Proposed reforms to Massachusetts law governing non-competition agreements
- Implications of the recent legalization of medical and recreational marijuana
- The recently adopted "Bathroom Bill," and what it means for employers

We will also discuss current best practices for conducting background checks, developments in the drafting of workplace policies governing bullying and the use of social media.

Finally, we will look ahead to 2017 and beyond, analyzing how the election results might impact issues such as immigration-related hiring practices, the role of the NLRB, minimum wage reform and parental leave.
